- Purchasing, where appropriate and viable, goods that are made from recycled materials.

- Offering customers a recycling service that enables them to reduce their wastage and therefore their impact on the environment.

- Supporting and participating in local initiatives and organisations designed to promote sustainability by sharing knowledge, best practices and joint actions.
- Continually improving our performance to further limiting our impact on the environment.

We will proactively promote the efficient use of energy and natural resources by monitoring use and implementing cost-effective programs to increase efficiency, increase the use of alternative and substitute materials, and reduce emissions and waste.

We occupy buildings that have been designed to make the best use of natural light and energy. We are committed to the reduction of our carbon footprint and minimising our impact as a company on the environment.



We will monitor the use of electrical energy and water at all of our offices and facilities.

In addition the following programs have been initiated at a number of our facilities:

- Energy efficient lighting systems with PIR sensors.
- Energy efficient lamps thought out the building.
- · Switching off all hot water geysers at the end of the work day.
- Maximising our use of environmentally aware suppliers.
- · Use of recycled material in the boxes used for paper storage in our facilities.
- Managing water usage by ensuring that any leaks in pipes, hoses, taps or couplings are reported and repaired.
- · Only printing documents when it is absolutely necessary.
- · Shredding and recycling all our paper waste.

We will continue to meet the needs of the present, without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs. We are committed to sustainable development that addresses environmental, economic and social factors as well as the interrelationships between them.

Metrofile will use its expertise, technology and resources to:

- · encourage customers to use environmentally friendly services,
